

## **St Clair Special Emergency Services to Train on the Quail Club Grounds**

Over the next several months The St. Clair Special Emergency Services will be training on the grounds of the Quail Club. This elite volunteer group are involved with missing or lost people over the entire Metro East area, and just recently assisted in the search and rescue of Joshua Childers.

The training will include live Search and Rescue Missions, with the group actually having a victim in the woods and fields located at the club. The club will also share with spectators and participants techniques that assist lost victims in assisting in their rescue.

The group will use their trained dogs and other search equipment to locate strategically placed victims on the grounds of the Quail Club. This elite group is involved in school education programs and spreading the word on their **HUG A TREE** exercise, which teaches children steps to take if they ever become lost in unfamiliar territory.

All members and especially their children/grandchildren are invited to attend and more importantly participate in the search and locate activities. The first training session will be held Thursday, May 21<sup>st</sup> at approximately 6:30 PM.

Quail Club member Gordon Fietsam has organized this activity, and hope to see many of our members come out and watch these volunteers provide a valuable service to our area.
